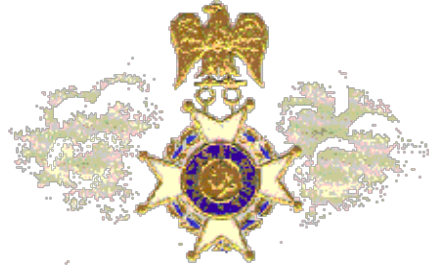


# Sons of the American Revolution
